



ACORD Claims Messages 810 First Notice of Loss Submission

Function

- · Used to initiate claim processing by providing notification of the possibility of a Claim.
- Provides initial notification of a potential benefit under a policy due to the occurrence of an insured event or peril, for example death
- This message could be passed between an agency/distributor initiating a loss notification to a Carrier.
- A common scenario is first notice of death, whereby someone (notifier) is letting an insurer know that a person has died who
 may (they believe) have an insured interest in a policy, thus potentially triggering a Claim for a death benefit under the policy
 payable to the beneficiaries of the policy.
- · Actions that result from the receipt of this notification are expected to vary by Product and Carrier.

Related Messages

- 820 Claim Status Inquiry used to allow the sender to request a Claim status from the Carrier, with the expectation of a response.
- 1820 Claim Status Notification used to communicate the status of a Claim from the Carrier to the Agent(s) on a policy.
- 890 Death Inquiry used to do a search on Death Notification services, such as the Social Security Administration's Death Master File (DMF), or other databases or vital record sources to see if a potential match appears for any deceased owners and/or insured/annuitants.

Additional Information

- DTCC refers to the 810 First Notice of Loss as Death Notification in their implementation of this message.
- Provides the Receiver with a notification that the Requestor has been contacted regarding an event that has occurred relating to an insured entity, and may result in a Claim being filed under one or more Holdings.
- · Does not create the Claim, but merely functions as the notification of the possibility of a Claim.
