#### **Function**

- · Used to interface with a disbursement subsystem (engine), which sends payments out.
- · Transaction Sub Types:
  - o 22000 General Disbursement Transaction
  - o 22001 Commission Payment
  - o 22002 Annuity Payout
  - o 22003 Claims Payment
  - 22004 Policy Withdrawal Payments

## **Related Messages**

- 184 Billing Information Administration used to change billing information on an in force or pending policy.
- 185 Financial Activity Administration record various financial activities such as premium or loan payments.
- 208 Billing Information Inquiry used to request billing information
- 213 & 1213 Financial Activity Inquiry & Transmittal
  used to display to the end user the financial transactions
  that have been processed or scheduled to occur for a
  contract. 1213 Transmittal is used to push information.
- 508 Payment Submission used to make payments into a policy.
- 509 Loan Processing Submission used to submit a request for a loan or a loan reversal.

## **EDI to XML Mappings**

• There is no equivalent EDI mapping for these messages.

#### **Additional Information**

- This transaction provides a common way to send payments out of an organization. It standardizes the way Commissions, Claims, Payouts, Withdrawals, etc. are disbursed from a policy or contract.
- This single message may interact with a Data Integration Hub (DIH) for the various disbursement types and may ultimately go to a vendor (like SAP) to make the actual payment (via check, wire, ACH).
- The 508 Payment transaction provides a standardized means by which to make payments INTO a policy or contract.
