On June 29th, over 180 members of our global Ruschlikon community got together in Singapore, Zurich, and New York to celebrate 15 years of hard work driving digital change and transformation across our global industry.

The Ruschlikon initiative - powered by ACORD – has been championing standardisation, digitisation, automation, and straight-through-processing in (re)insurance since its foundation in 2008. No other industry body has applied ACORD's data standards as holistically as Ruschlikon has – covering all steps in the (re)insurance value chain, from bid to bind to accounting, claims and settlement in a transparent, collaborative, trusted way.

Celebrations in all 3 locations included tailored keynote speakers followed by expert panel discussions, which were a great way to inspire a deeper dialogue on key topics and increase participant engagement. In addition, with panellists representing different companies, it was a great way to share and learn from their experiences in implementing Ruschlikon, as well as hear about other digitisation/automation efforts underway in their companies to support industry transformation. The keynotes also explored other

digitisation-related topics – such as the importance of change leadership, data, and technology in our journey.

Here are some of the highlights and takeaways from all 3 celebrations:


- **Data, people, and technology are the key enablers** when it comes to digitising and automating our core business and unlocking new, strategic options – and that isn't just true for (re)insurance but for all industries
- **You can't digitise the human element of our industry.** We all still want to interact with real people, in addition to taking advantage of the benefits of digitised service offerings
- **Standardisation, digitisation and automation are essential to achieve straight-through processing.** It's no longer a question of "IF" but "WHEN" we do it, each and every incremental step is important in shifting us further towards success. **It's a marathon, not a sprint**
- **The main hurdle for straight-through-processing resides in our own organisations** – specifically in the lack of a strong connection between digitisation efforts/investment and the business strategy. Ruschlikon's data and process standards provide the tools we need to achieve digitisation goals – and as leaders, we also need to do our part to influence and make sure that these tech targets are firmly embedded in and aligned with the business enterprise strategy
- **Leading by example is critical to our movement.** Your passion for what we're doing and trying to achieve are mirrored in your actions and words – don't underestimate the impact you can have!
- **The success of our joint transformation relies on change leadership with strong EQ.** We have to address the emotional why, what and how to bring people along with us. Also, we can't forget that change is often linked with new skills and ways of doing things. Make best use of the opportunities to engage and train your people



The audience was given an outlook on the topics to tackle in the years to come:

- Focus on the end-to-end value chain, aim for digitisation and automation from bid to bind, to accounting, claims and settlement
- Standardisation and digitisation are the first steps, integration brings the full benefits
- Make the London market modernisation a success – Ruschlikon supports Blueprint Two
- Leverage the resources that Ruschlikon offers and be an ambassador for the community
